Stained Glass Windows

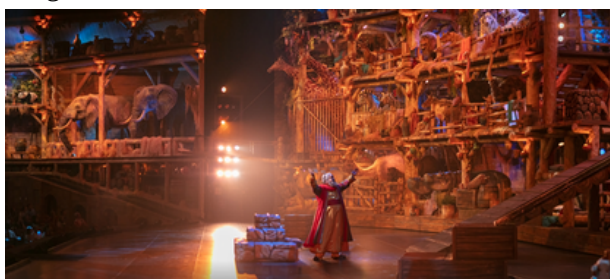
On June 8, the Feast of Pentecost, there was a blessing of the refurbished stained-glass windows.
